RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1) VFW Post 4816 will not be liable for THEFT, DAMAGE, and OR ACCIDENTS.
- 2) Absolutely NO FIREARMS or EXPLOSIVES.
- 3) The cooking area will be marked off. Spaces are on first come first serving basis.
- 4) All must be inspected before cooking. All entries per team should be inspected at one time. NO pre-seasoning or pre-cooking allowed. Marinating allowed ONLY after inspection.
- 5) NO sauce or garnish may be added to entries at judging time. Sauces may be used as a "SOP" during cooking, but NOT poured on for presentation.
- 6) Each Chief Cook is responsible for having his/her entry at the judging area at the proper time.
- 7) Contestants must supply all needed equipment and supplies. NO GAS or ELECTRIC cookers for BAR-B-QUE. All fires must be contained.
- 8) Amplification should be used in moderation. Quiet time is from 12:00 a.m.-6:00 a.m.
- 9) Contestants will not sell any BAR-B-QUE to the public.
- 10) Each team will be responsible for the clean up of their space. The Chief Cook will be responsible for the conduct of HIS/HER Team and Guests.
- 11) Contest Committeemen reserve the right to make additional rules and regulations as a situation warrants. Decisions of the Committee and Judges will be final.
- 12) Excessive use of alcoholic beverages could be grounds for disqualification.
- 13) The Head Cook meeting will be Saturday, April 28 at 9:00 a.m.
- 14) No more than two cook teams per pit.
- 15) Check-in starts at 10:00 a.m. Friday 27.
- 16) Turn-in times will be Saturday 28 as follows:
BEANS-11:00 a.m., CHICKEN-12:00 p.m., RIBS-1:00 p.m., BRISKET-2:00 p.m.
