Phillip DuBois, a Gold Legacy Life Member of the Brazos County VFW Post 4692 in Bryan, Texas, was appointed as State Inspector by State Commander Norman Macey at the Special Called Meeting on September 26, 2021, at VFW Post 4816 in Porter, Texas.

A VFW member since 2009, Comrade DuBois served as Commander of VFW Post 4458 in Caldwell, Texas, for 3 years (2014-2017) where he earned All-American Commander (2016-2017).

He was elected District 17 Commander (2017-2018) and earned honors as an All -American District Commander. He was elected District 17 Quartermaster in 2018 and remains in that position currently. He earned the honor of All-American Quartermaster (2018-2019). He received the Glen M. Gardner, Jr. Outstanding Quartermaster Award (2020-2021) at the State Convention.

Comrade DuBois was appointed as National Aide-de-Camp (2014-2015, 2016-2017, and 2017-2018). He was appointed National Inspector General in 2019-2020, and National Special Aide-de-Camp (2020-2021).

Comrade DuBois served in the United States Army for twenty (20+) years earning his VFW eligibility while serving in Vietnam two (2) tours. He also had one tour in Germany. He had eight (8) TET offenses and 225 Combat flight hours. He crewed several different single engine and multi-engine aircrafts to include one that carried top secret radios on board that were used to spy on the enemy in Vietnam. He also was an Air Traffic Controller and Air Traffic Controller Instructor.

His last nine (9) years of service was with the active-duty National Guard in Marana, Arizona. There he played a vital role in training as many as 700 students a year on how to maintain and fly the OH-58 and AH-1 Cobra and AH-64 Apache Helicopters.

Comrade DuBois earned the Bronze Star Medal, Air Medal 11th Award, Good Conduct Medal 3rd, National Defense Service Medal with Star, Vietnam Service Medal with 8 campaigns, Republic of Vietnam Service Medal with 60 Device, Republic of Vietnam Combat Medal with Palm, Republic of Vietnam with Unit citation, National Defense Service Medal 2nd award, and the Aircraft Crewman badge.

Born in Ft. Bragg, North Carolina and retiring from the military, Comrade DuBois and his wife, Denise, live in Caldwell Texas. He has 3 adult children, 6 grandchildren and 3 great grandchildren.
