Randall Johnston, a Gold Legacy Member of Post 4376 in Seven Points, was elected in June 2022 as State Surgeon at the 102nd Department of Texas VFW State Convention held in Durant, Oklahoma.

Comrade Johnston was a Department V.A.V.S. Representative North Texas Health Care System (Dallas) appointed by Doc Howard. He served as Deputy Representative four years before with over 1200 volunteer hours.

He first held office within the Texas VFW as Quartermaster at Post 5076-Garland, and has gone thru the chairs at both Post and District levels. Comrade Johnston served as District 30 Commander (2015-2016, 2017-2018, 2019-2020), District 3 Commander (2005-2006), Post 5076-Garland Commander, Post 4376-Seven Points Commander (2013-2019). He was All-American District Commander (2015-2016, 2019-2020), All-State District and Post Commander (2015-2016).

He earned his VFW eligibility serving in the U. S. Marine Corps 1966-1969 and in Vietnam 1966-1968. Medals received include National Defense, Vietnam Service with three bronze stars, Vietnam Campaign with clasp, Presidential Unit Citation, Vietnamese Cross of Gallantry, and Good Conduct ribbon.
