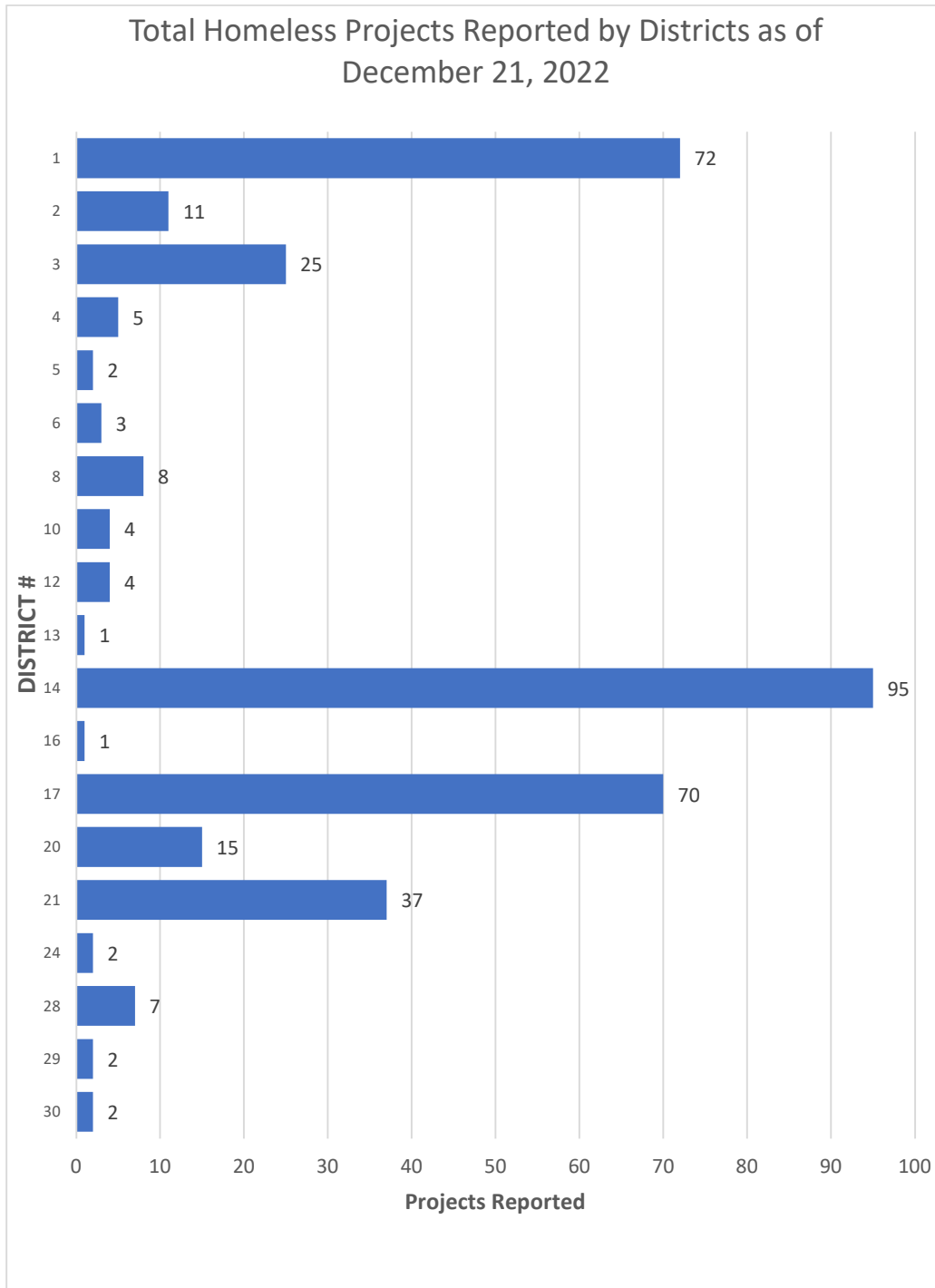


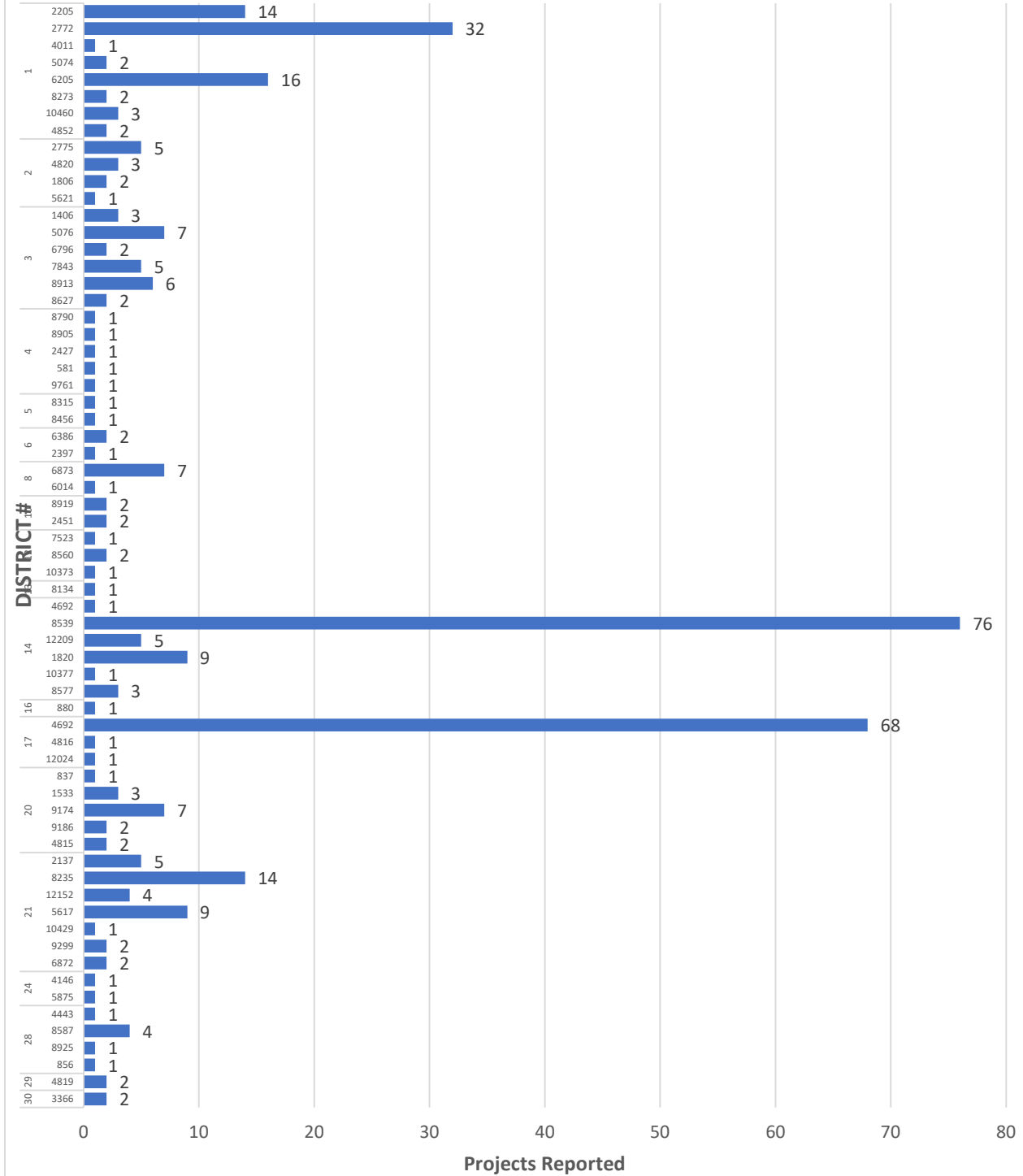
Texas VFW Homeless Veterans Chairman's Report as of December 27, 2022



Total Homeless Projects Reported by Posts in Districts as of December 21, 2022



If your district isn't listed, ensure that your posts are reporting their homeless projects. This can be done by clicking "Yes" on the homeless project button on the Community Service Reporting.



Texas VFW Foundation has established an Homeless Veterans Grant process to get up to \$500 reimbursement for your project, but you need to work with a bonified homeless project, and your post/district should have donated to the Foundation. Look for the link on the page and follow the process in the documentation.



Below are VA Scheduled Stand Downs for this year. I will notify those District Commanders via these reports if anything changes.

Stand Downs are typically one-to-three-day events during which VA staff and volunteers provide food, clothing and health screenings to homeless and at-risk Veterans. In addition,
