- **4.** <u>Post Nominations/Election of Officers:</u> In accordance with Section 217 of the Manual Procedure, nominations of Post Officers shall be open in March and Election of Officers shall be concluded in April.
 - **NOTE:** Post election reports should be filed shortly after the final nomination and Election of Officers at the April or May District meetings. Posts should use the Online Membership System (OMS) on the National VFW website. Once filed in OMS, an automated copy with be sent to the Department.
- **5.** <u>All-State:</u> The Department will not accept any All-State documentation and/or checks until **May 1, 2023**. The stats that show who have achieved this will not be accurate until that date, as qualifications are not complete.
- **6.** <u>103rd Annual State Convention-Department of Texas VFW:</u> The Annual State Convention is scheduled for June 8-11, 2023, in Dallas, Texas, at the Hilton Anatole. The room block is currently sold out for the Hilton Anatole. Please check the Texas VFW website for updates on overflow accommodations in the area.
- 7. <u>2023 Officer Training Seminar (OTS):</u> OTS is scheduled for July 6-9, 2023, in Austin, Texas, at the Renaissance Hotel. The room block will be open for reservations on April 1st.
- **8.** <u>124th VFW National Convention:</u> National VFW Convention is scheduled for July 22-27, 2023. The room block opened on February 17th and will sell out quickly. Please visit the National website for more information.
